多義語 run

1. 遺伝する(自動詞) Ex. The desire for adventure runs in his family.

2. 経営する(他動詞)= manage Ex. My mother runs a big company.

参考 1 多義語 case

1. 事実(the を伴う) Ex. That's the case with him. 「彼に当てはまる」

be the case with = be true of

2. 事件 Ex. a civil / criminal case「民事 / 刑事事件」

3. 症例 Ex. several cased of measles「麻疹の症例」

4. 主張(通例単数形) Ex. She made a good case for doing it alone.

※ a case for / against A「A に賛成 / 反対の主張」

参考 2 多義語 company

1. 一緒にいること(不可算名詞) Ex. I enjoyed her company / the company of her.

※ A's company / the company of A「A と一緒」

2. 仲間(不可算名詞) Ex. A man is known by the company he keeps.

= You can tell a man by the company he keeps.

「付き合う仲間を見ればその人が分かる.」

3. 来客(不可算名詞) = guest Ex. I am having company this evening.

参考 3 多義語 meet

1. 満たす(他動詞)= satisfy Ex. We cannot meet the demands of the hijacker.

2. 対処する (他動詞) = deal with Ex. I must meet their criticism.
